Issues in High School Academic History Section

1. High Schools Attended: Enter your high school(s)

If you REPEATED an A-G course during **summer school** at OFL or Mission View, add the school:

OFL= 051506 OPPORTUNITIES LRN-WILLIAM HART

Mission View=054178 Mission View Public School

DON'T add Hart District schools, Math Support or Valencia Tutors. You will add these classes/grades using AOC as the school.

2. ALL COC classes will be recorded in the next section: Colleges & Courses

3. You ONLY include A-G courses in the Academic History section for both AOC and COC. Use the spreadsheet.

4. H Government and H Econ are one semester classes. You'll put "IP" for in progress for HGov and "PL" for planned for HEcon. Put "NO" for the semester you aren't taking the class. HEcon is in G: College-Prep Elective.

Issues in Colleges & Courses Academic History Section

1. Indicate you attended COC from August of 10th grade to June 2020 if you've been at AOC since ninth grade. None of the college courses you took in 9th grade are A-G so you CAN'T put them. If you put that you went to COC in ninth grade, it forces you to add classes in ninth grade which is wrong.

2. You will include in the OTHER ACADEMIC HISTORY section that you attended COC during ninth grade but took non-A-G courses during that year.

3. You'll be able to use the drop downs for most courses. COC's A-G list was last updated in 2013-14 and you may not see your course in the drop downs. For those courses not in the drop downs, you MAY have to ADD them. The instructions say to use ASSIST BUT you should use the spreadsheet to see if your course should be added to this section of the application OR not. NOT all college courses should be added to this section.

4. For EACH course, you will have to choose the Subject Area. USE the spreadsheet. BE CAREFUL!

5. Math 060 = Algebra I, Math 070 = Algebra 2, Math 075 = Algebra 2, Math 083 = Geometry. These are NOT college level so leave the Honors Status as NH

Since you completed high school Algebra I, Algebra 2(Trig), and Geometry and took Math 060, 070, 075 OR 083, select Elective-Mathematics in the Subject Area

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6. For science courses with a 1 unit additional lab, you won't see the lab in the drop down so you would have to add the course. Check the spreadsheet.

7. ALL COC Language 101 classes meet the 2-year LOTE requirement. Select "Yr 2" in the drop down.

Academic History/Additional Information:

1. CA SSID is located on your transcript in the top left box titled Student Information. It is the 10 digit number next to State ID

2. Additional Comments: Since this follows your academic history, consider these suggestions:

- a) If you started AOC in ninth grade, include that you attended COC during ninth grade and completed college transferable non-A-G courses: CAWT 140 Survey of Microsoft Programs for 3 units with a grade of ___ and Counseling 111 Intro to College & Strategies for Success for 1 unit with a grade of ___. Include your grades.
- b) If you received a low grade or unusual grade, you can use this area to address it.
- c) You SHOULD DEFINITELY include earning AA/AS degree(s) in this section.
- d) If you are not getting a degree but will be finished with the IGETC and certified, include it.
- e) You can use this section to put non-A-G classes that won't fit in the Activities and Awards section if you are using that section's 5 spots for AOC classes like ASB, Yearbook, Tutoring, etc.

Activities and Awards

You can put up to 20 activities and awards in this section. Use this area for ASB, Yearbook, Student Tutor, and non-A-G courses that were SIGNIFICANT to you. Do NOT put Advisement, PE, or Health in this area. Use the spreadsheet for the non-A-G courses and the information needed.

Personal Insight ADDITIONAL Comments

This is the last area you can provide additional information.

The Instructions read: If there's anything else you want us to know about you, now's your chance. But remember, you should use this space only if you want to describe anything that you have not had the opportunity to include elsewhere in the application. This shouldn't be an essay, but rather a place to explain unusual personal or family circumstances, or anything that may be unclear in other parts of the application.

What you put in this section depends on what you included in the Academic History/Additional Information section. If you haven't included anything about choosing AOC and how it affected your educational goals, you can do that here. Otherwise, look at the suggestions given above.
